We have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking. In a committed endeavour, to ensure all those in our supply chain and contractors comply with our ethics, we require them to comply with

the ETI Base Code and our Anti-Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy which gives our workers, contractors and other business partners guidance on slavery and human trafficking and the measures taken by our organisation to tackle slavery and human trafficking in our business and supply chains.

TRAINING

To ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains and our business, we provide training to our staff and require our business partners to meet our ethical standards.

We are committed to this high training standard, having a Key Performance Indicator to measure our progress. All of our staff will undergo MSAT modern slavery awareness training annually, which we will provide by annual refresher training. As this is integral to our business, 100% of our staff who work directly with our supply chain have undergone this training.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending March 2024.
